

Powis Green Space Project

Successfully gained funding for the following:

- 2 x floodlights to be installed at rear of shops in the Woody Park
- 2 x goal posts to be installed (7-a-side football pitch size) at rear of shops in Woody Park

Ean Emslie has given permission to:

- Install two metal gates at either end of the alley way at the side of the Bedford Avenue store. The Powis Residents Group will meet this cost with the funding they secured from Police Scotland

Further funding is currently being sought to refurbish the:

- Zip Slide
- Canteliever Swing

Aberdeen Greenspace Trust Ltd is funding the costs of:

- 1 x bench to be installed near the football pitch area in the Woody Park
- 1 x picnic table to be installed near the football pitch area in the Woody Park

and Aberdeen City Council have just taken an order in for this.

Aberdeen City Council have recommended that Bow Top Fencing (as shown in the image below) in line with other fencing being installed around Aberdeen Play Parks be installed at the end of the Woody Park near the electric substation. This type of fencing is low maintenance and will also enhance the safety in the area. The fencing will be set back from the road and will run from the wall at the rear of the houses on Bedford Road to the corner of the substation wall with a self closing gate.

Aberdeen City Council have added this to a larger ongoing project and have therefore agreed to meet the cost of the installation of:

- New Fence with self closing gate to be installed at end of Woody Park



We're also looking at the possibility of the path and stairs being installed to create a walkway down to the new gate/fence from Powis Crescent and funding is being sought for this. An official path would come with the benefit of having lighting installed and would therefore enhance the security of the park area even further.
